II. Academic Disqualification, Probation, and Grievances

A. Academic Disqualification

A student: 1) who has not successfully completed any required course on the second attempt; or 2) whose cumulative grade point average at the end of the second or any subsequent semester is less than 2.00, is disqualified from registration for continuation in the academic program except as provided for below. For purposes of this rule, any course work completed during the summer will be treated as if it was taken after the end of the spring semester. If the student is determined to be ineligible before the drop date for any classes in which the student is then currently enrolled, the student will be administratively dropped from those courses. If the student is determined to be ineligible after the drop date, the student will be allowed to complete any classes in which the student is then currently enrolled, but the grades from the classes will not be considered in assessing the student's disqualification for any subsequent term, although the grades may be considered by the Probation Committee in assessing the student's application to continue the academic program on probation.
