

III. Policies for Admissions and Transfer, Visiting, and Non Degree Students

C. Admission with Advance Standing

A student may be admitted to the School of Law with advanced standing based upon credit received from a law school that is not accredited by the ABA or from a law school located outside the United States, in accordance with applicable ABA accreditation standards. No more than one-third of the credits required for graduation from this law school may be awarded as advance standing. Course grades will be transferred to UND with the grades earned or their equivalent, if such can be extrapolated. Courses in which the student was awarded a grade lower than "C" or its equivalent will not be accepted.
